WHO SHOULD ATTEND

We welcome the participation of interdisciplinary teams from a single institution across student services, academics, institutional research/ effectiveness, and other areas. The courses are designed for two- and four-year institutional users with PDP dashboards.

Accelerator Onboarding Course

March 12–April 20, 2024

This course prepares participants to complete the nuts and bolts of a comprehensive PDP data-submission that will maximize dashboard functionality, inform better decisions, and use data to advance equity.

Using PDP for Data Discovery & Decision Support Course

May 20–June 28, 2024

This course uses intersectional data to explore previously unanswerable questions, identify gaps, assess progress in closing gaps, and leverage the PDP to support decision-making. It is not simply about how to operate the dashboards but, rather, focuses on how to use the metrics in the dashboards to drive change.
