## Using PDP for Data Discovery & Decision Support Course

**September 30 – November 8, 2024**

The course uses intersectional data to explore previously unanswerable questions, identify gaps, assess progress in closing gaps, and leverage the PDP to support decision making. It is not simply about how to operate the dashboards, but rather, focuses on how to use the metrics and the extensive filtering options in the dashboards to drive change.
